Camper Eligibility:

Campbell County 4-H Camp is open to all youth residents of Campbell County who are 9-13 years old. If you are not sure if your child is eligible, please call our office. The following age limitations apply:

- Campers must be 9 years old on or before September 30, 2018.
- Older campers are eligible as long as they were no older than 13 years old as of January 1, 2018.
