1/3 c. red cinnamon candies

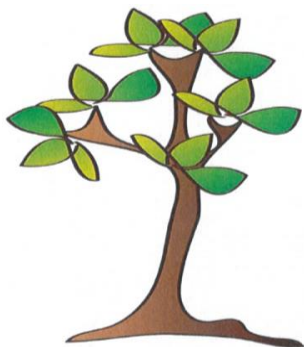
Few drops of red food coloring

Apples of your choice

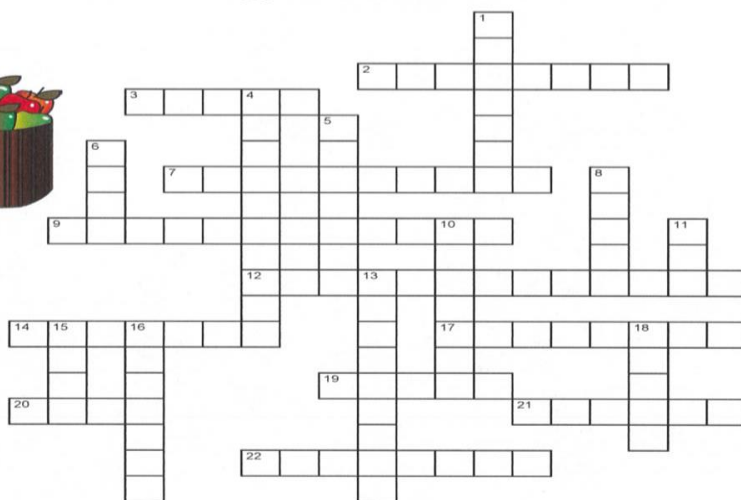


Make a syrup of the water, sugar, red candy, and food coloring. Pare and core apples, then slice into ½ inch rings. Cook in syrup until tender.
