



### **SOVA Agribusiness Information Technology Program**

Final Round — Applications now available! Final Deadline 9/15/17.

Funded by Tobacco Commission Region Revitalization Commission

Approximately 80 farmers across 18 eligible Southside counties, who are accepted into SAITP will be awarded 33.3% cost share funding (up to \$1,200 per producer) on information technology tools for farms including laptop computers, QuickBooks financial recordkeeping software, Cattle Pro and Farm Logic production recordkeeping software, and professional website development. In addition, participants will have opportunities to participate in educational programs on information technology tools and practices. The objective of the program is to increase producer productivity, by identifying producers who are willing to introduce information technology into their business management and marketing strategies, for an overall increase in net farm income, either from increased revenue, decreased expenses or increased efficiency.
